<p style="text-align: center;">Buddy Sort</p> <p>Ask a family member to give you your words, then you spell the word and sort the word.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>RECORD YOUR WORDS.</u></p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Syllable Clapping</p> <p><u>RECORD YOUR WORDS.</u> Then clap out the number of syllables you hear in each word. Write the number of syllables you heard beside the word.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Spelling City</p> <p>Visit www.spellingcity.com. Enter your words and choose a game to play. Remember, you have to type in your own words.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Guess the Word</p> <p>Use your finger to write each word on a friend or family member's back. See if they can guess each word as you write it.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>RECORD YOUR WORDS.</u></p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Free Choice</p> <p>Do any activity of your choice to practice your words. (You can make up an activity.) On the lines below, write what you did to practice your words.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>RECORD YOUR WORDS.</u></p> <hr/> <hr/> <hr/>	<p style="text-align: center;">Beat the Adult</p> <p>An adult or older sibling sorts the words while being timed by you. Then you try to beat the person's time while sorting your words. On paper, record the sort, write who won, and explain why you think that person won.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>BE SURE TO RECORD YOUR WORDS.</u></p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Define Words</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>RECORD YOUR KEYWORDS ONLY.</u></p> <p>Choose 2 words from each category to define. You can either define the words in your own words or use a dictionary to look up the true definitions. Record the 2 words you choose from each category AND the definitions. (You do NOT need to record every word and definition, unless you want to do so.)</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Synonyms / Antonyms</p> <p>Find synonyms or antonyms for each of your spelling words. Write the synonym or antonym next to the word on the sort. Not all words have a synonym or antonym, so check with an adult if you can't figure one out. If there isn't a synonym or antonym, write "NONE" next to the word.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>BE SURE TO RECORD YOUR WORDS.</u></p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Grammar</p> <p>Classify your words into different parts of speech such as nouns, verbs, and adjectives. Write the parts of speech next to each word on the sort.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">*Use a dictionary to help you!*</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><u>BE SURE TO RECORD YOUR WORDS.</u></p>
