The Shaker Heights City School District has adopted Compass Learning for students in grades 3-6 for the 2015-2016 school year. This is a web-based curriculum that will enhance your child's educational experience. Compass Learning allows students and parents to access the program from their home computer and includes newly designed learning activities based on the latest research in reading and math content areas. Compass Learning is aligned with both our current growth assessment instrument, NWEA's Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) assessments and Ohio's learning standards. The program utilizes data from your child's MAP testing session and creates individualized learning programs. Each activity emphasizes critical skills needed to prepare students for college and careers. In addition, the program offers comprehensive reporting features to assess your child's progress.

Below you will find information on how to access Compass Learning outside of school. We are very pleased to be able to offer your child an opportunity to continue his/her learning experience outside of the classroom. Should you have any questions, please feel free to contact your child's teacher or building principal.

## Directions:

- Access for Compass Learning can be attained by typing <http://www.compasslearningodyssey.com> into your web browser.
- Enter Login id: student's first initial and last name all in lower case\*
- Password: last 4 digits of the student's id number
- \*Exceptions occur if there are multiple students with the same first initial and last name, then a number starting at 1 is added.  
Example: If there are two students with names like Sam Brown and Sarah Brown, then Sam's login would be /sbrown1/ and Sarah's login would be /sbrown2/.

This is the same login and password as Success Maker. Students go on Compass Learning everyday at school—so the kids know the login and password by heart. Please be sure that **Boulevard** is spelled correctly in the "school" section. If it isn't, the login doesn't work.
